The Embassy Suites is a highly rated hotel chain. The rooms are two-room suites with at least 500 square feet, complete with a microwave, mini-refrigerator, its own living room and two sinks. The rooms have two double beds (or a king-size bed) plus a couch/sofa bed in the living room. This year we may be limited in the number of queen bed units we can reserve so some may need to have the king bed suites (less expensive).

Our meeting room is near the atrium on the main level. A complimentary buffet breakfast is included for those spending the night.

This Embassy Suites Hotel is centrally located in Orange County, adjacent to the 55 freeway at Dyer Road, only a couple miles from John Wayne airport. A shuttle service is available from John Wayne airport to and from the Embassy. Please call the hotel for details.

Directions from the 55 freeway (the hotel is south of the I-5 interchange and north of the 405): If you are going south on the 55 freeway, take the second Dyer Rd. exit (East Dyer). If you are going north on the 55, take the Dyer Rd. exit and go left. The hotel is on the west side of the freeway and can easily be seen from the freeway.
